Board Meeting Minutes
June 16, 2009

Call to Order

The Board Meeting of the CKMS PTSA was called to order in the CKMS library by Tammy Klupar at 6:33pm. All Members received proper notice of the meeting. A quorum was present. A sign-in sheet is attached.

Approval of Minutes

The April 15, 2009 Board Meeting minutes were approved as written.

President's Report (Tammy Klupar, Lori Hollasch)

Tammy thanked the board members and committee chairs for their hard work and dedication to CKMS PTSA. Lori thanked everyone as well, Lori also mentioned a new no effort fundraiser www.snoqualmieridge.org, businesses can purchase a banner ad for \$100-\$1000 per year and the entire payment goes directly to a local PTSA organization of the advertiser's choice. Lori announced that school supplies packs will be available for purchase; you can also pre-order your pack, available for pickup on CKMS Payment Day. The packs will be sold for \$15.00. Lastly, Lori encouraged everyone to come out the 3 on 3 basketball tournament being held at FCES during Fall City Days.

Co-President's Report (Lois Bauer, Kaila Russell)

Lois thanked Tammy and Lori for their great leadership this year.

Treasurer's Report (Pennie Treado)

The May 2009 financial reports were distributed and the treasury books were on hand. Char Yotz reviewed and initialed the bank statements.

Principal's Report (Kirk Dunckel)

Kirk reported that a schedule model for the next school year is set. CKMS has lost 2 staff members for the upcoming school year due to budget cuts, a physical education teacher and the librarian. Kirk has worked out a schedule with the staff volunteering in a rotating schedule to keep the librarian open during school hours. The staff members will be trained on library procedures/duties. Kirk is trying to keep the library open during lunches with the instructions assistants helping out during that time. Kirk said that if any money comes back from the state that all SVSD principals have asked that librarians are first on the list to return to work.

Kirk reported that they are close to an agreement on a plan to keep middle school sports and said a proposal will be presented to the SVSD Board this month. All sports will remain the same, although the number of coaches will be reduced which means the amount of play time for JV and below will be minimal, the varsity program would remain the same. Coaches would take a reduction of pay and students will pay to play, the costs could be \$75 for football, \$50 for all other sports and \$25 for clubs. Kirk did mention that he is trying to build a scholarship program. A question was raised about where the money from the 3 on 3 tournament and other fundraisers for Middle School Sports would go, Kirk stated that it is uncertain, but likely ASB, Booster, or possibly the scholarship fund.

Monday, June 22nd yearbooks will be distributed and there will be an all school BBQ. Tuesday, June 23rd each class will go on a field trip, 8th grade to Wild Waves, 7th grade to Woodland Park Zoo and the 6th grade will be going to Skate King. Wednesday, June 24th is the last day of school. Teachers are to have their final grades in by June 22nd. Grades will be mailed home to parents.

Committee Reports

Activity Blitz (Lois Bauer & Melissa Blucher)

Art Show (Kristen Minner)

Kristen has been assisting Julie Legace with the various art shows. The first art show was an all district show held at MSHS with artwork from elementary school to high school participants. The second show was last week at Twin Falls Middle School; the participants were 8th graders from all three SVSD middle schools. The most recent art show was at CKMS during the book fair, the pieces were book inspired, there were only two participants but they hope to grow that show next year.

Book Fair (Kara Spalding)

Kara reported that book fair raised \$2,035.07, after taxes. Kara reported that 980.00 worth of books are being purchased for the library with an additional \$240 available to be spent at the beginning of the next school year.

8th Grade Celebration (Renee Lovell & Debra McClain)

Lori reported that the final plans for the 8th grade celebration are nearly complete. This committee has a \$900 budget after parent donations. This committee is looking for a limo to borrow for pictures only, for a “red carpet/Hollywood” effect.

Staff Appreciation (Kari Takacs & Laura Nordby)

Kari and Laura have purchased beach towels to give to each teacher as an end of the year thank you from the CKMS PTSA.
